SISTERS: Meet 1st & 3rd Tuesdays, Jan 17th and Feb 7th & 21st, 6:30pm

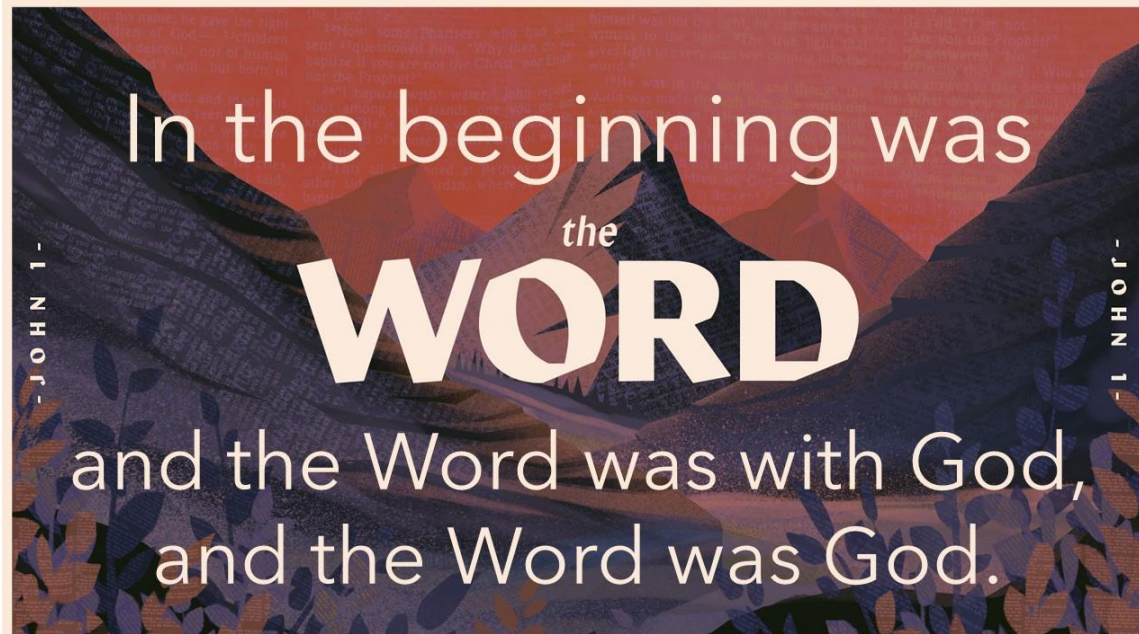
