Nursery-Teens: Wednesdays at 7:00pm (teens meet in Teen Room)

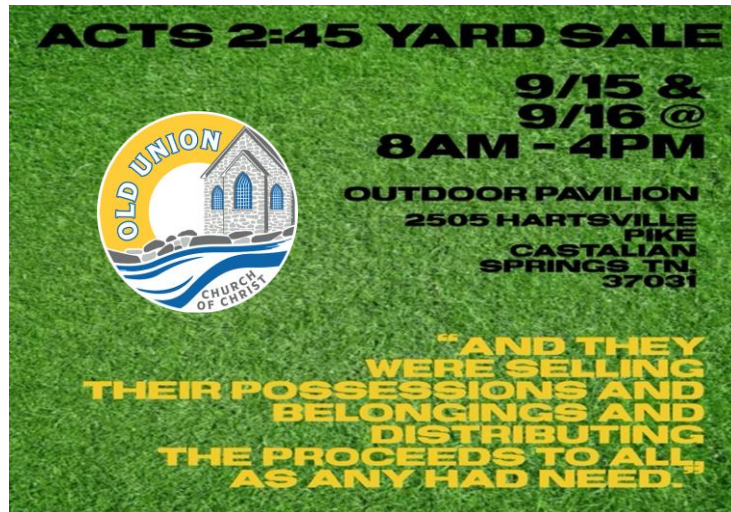
